Presentation Software

NAFRI's system works on Microsoft software. Presentations using Google Slides, Apple's Keynote and other presentation software often cause technical difficulties. Please use PowerPoint by Microsoft.

Slide Layout

- Widescreen works best on our monitors.
- Black or dark slide backgrounds are recommended over white or light backgrounds.

Video Wall



As shown in the image above, there are lines between the monitors. The video wall consists of 25 monitors (5 rows of 5). Black slide backgrounds help a lot. Graphs, images, and text may not display well if they fall into these monitor gap lines. Use this video tutorial to size and place your content on your slides that will look good on the video wall <https://youtu.be/v0SfrDiJNMk>. There are also side monitors that students can view even if the video wall obscures a graph or text.

Presenter Notes

Due to the way our audio/visual system is set up and because presenter mobility is highly encouraged for improved audience interaction and learning outcomes, we do not display presenter notes on confident monitors. If you need to rely on presenter notes, please be prepared to use printed notes. Our hands-free microphones and small, simple remote control will allow you to move around and interact with your audience with one hand free for your notes.

Dress
